Report for Weber Memorial 2019

Weber Memorial had another successful season but still with a reduced number of events. The grounds are always available for use by church and non-church groups. All events are scheduled through the conference office in Greensburg.

The caretaker, Tony Roland, purchased a new John Deere diesel tractor with a loader and mower deck last year for \$14,000. As per his housing agreement he purchases the equipment used to maintain the grounds. Since purchasing it he has used it to keep ahead of cutting the grass and leveling out asphalt millings left by Hempfield Township after a drainage project on Milliron Church Road.

A new oil furnace was purchase for the residence from Brown's Plumbing and Heating. The previous unit was very old and it was no longer feasible to maintain it. Unknown to me, it did not heat at all during the winter of 2017 and 2018.

Thomas Milliron Chapman has contacted me about a plan to renovate the cemetery. He manages a Milliron Family website and he has suggested ideas to raise funds to dedicate toward the cemetery.

Thank you to all the churches who send donations to Weber last year. The amount received covered about a third of the cost of the new furnace.

I will keep doing my best to allow Weber Memorial to be maintained as a place of peace and serenity for "as long as sun and moon shine, waters run and trees grow."
