During 2018, porticos were completed outside of The Heritage, The Ridgewood and The Villas - the culmination of the \$500,000 Raise the Roof campaign. Almost 100 major gift donors, residents, staff and legislators gathered to celebrate the ribbon-cutting on September 11, 2018. Thank you to everyone who supported this significant initiative. These porticos will shield our residents, family members and visitors from the weather for generations to come.



In April, we honored more than 200 volunteers who give of their time, talents and treasures to support the mission of St. Paul's. In 2018, 21,379 hours were contributed by adult and student volunteers. The number of new volunteers was 63. The value of volunteered time was \$524,144 - an amount equivalent to 10.21 full-time employees. Volunteers were comprised of 76 student volunteers and 212 adult volunteers. Volunteers use their gifts to impact the lives of residents and their families as well as our staff and visitors. Volunteers serve in countless ways including as appointment companions, with in-house resident transport needs, serving in The Bistro, labeling cloths, serving during special events, and so much more. We are grateful for everyone who donates their time to support the mission of St. Paul's.
