Why: The goals/purpose of this trip:

When: Target dates are April 26 – May 9, 2020 (12-14 day trip)

Cost: Estimated cost per person \$2,560.00

 - Money from the UCC East Asia/Pacific budget

What: activities will be done during the trip

- ✓ Possibly attend Northwest Luzon Jurisdiction UCCP Annual Conference
- ✓ Visit Northwest Luzon UCC Jurisdiction UCCP Conference headquarters
- ✓ Travel to local settings in the Northwest Luzon Jurisdiction UCCP to participate in mission projects
- ✓ Lodging in hotels in Manila. Lodging in Northwest Luzon to be determined by location of mission projects
