OFFICIAL CALL TO THE 56TH ANNUAL MEETING Lay Delegate, Youth Delegate, and Visitor Packet

"Putting on Our Love Shoes" is the theme of our 2018 Penn West Conference Annual Gathering & Meeting. We are meeting on Friday, June 8, and Saturday, June 9, at California University of Pennsylvania in California PA. This mailing serves as the Official Call to the meeting and contains information to be shared with those attending from your congregation.

Please remember that according to Article VII, paragraph 4, in our By-Laws:

4. When the Conference meets, its voting membership shall consist of the ordained, commissioned and licensed ministers holding standing in its Associations, and of lay delegates selected by and representing the member churches. A church of not more than 200 communicant members (members in full standing) shall be entitled to be represented by two lay delegates and a youth delegate; a church of 201-500 such members, by three lay delegates and a youth delegate; a church of more than 501 such members, by four lay delegates and a youth delegate. Youth delegates are those under the age of 19. ... Visitors are welcome with the privilege of voice but without vote. The members of the Board of Directors shall be voting members ex-officio.

This packet includes a Registration Form for each lay and youth delegate (pastors are sent their own packet). There is also an extra Registration Form that can be copied for visitors. Be sure to return all registration forms to 312 S. Maple Ave., Suite PWC, Greensburg PA 15601. Please also look for online registration at www.pennwest.org. THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE PENN WEST CONFERENCE ANNUAL GATHERING AND MEETING

Arrival and Welcome – Directions to California University and a campus map are included in this mailing. Overnight accommodations are in the Johnson Hall dormitory. We will have bright-vested volunteers available for help with moving in and registering. As you enter the campus, your first stop should be to temporarily park in the front of the Convocation Center to register. (If, for some reason, you need to spend more time here, you should utilize parking lot #11, near Gallagher Hall). Your second stop should then be to travel down Third Street and temporarily park by Johnson Hall to unload your vehicle (commuters, of course, may skip this step). Then you should proceed up Hickory Street and park in lot #17. If lot #17 becomes full, you may get a pass to park in lot #19. The dining hall is "Goldrush" in the Eberly Student Center. There is a 4-5 minute walk between the Convocation Center and Johnson Hall, and the dining hall is roughly in between these buildings. If you have mobility issues, golf carts are available to transport you. Be sure to let our volunteers know and they will be happy to assist you.

Bath Towels & Pillows – These are provided, but if you wish, you may bring your own.

Bookstore – We will again have our bookstore that will include a variety of United Church of Christ items. Credit cards, cash, and checks will be accepted. We are no longer able to invoice churches for payment.

Conference Choir – Everyone is welcome to sing in the choir for the Closing Worship on Saturday. Rehearsal times are announced in the schedule.

Dress – Dress is casual. Please bring an umbrella in case it rains!

Offerings – Our offering for our opening worship service on Friday afternoon will be directed toward the LeMoyne Center in Washington PA, via our Regional Youth Event efforts. The offering for our closing worship will be directed toward the fund to support the educational efforts (for children & pastors) in the Northwest Luzon Conference of the United Church of Christ in the Philippines (the SHEEP fund). We would like our churches to receive offerings for these in advance so that these gifts are received not simply from the delegates who attend but from our churches themselves. We are also hoping that our youth will receive a "noisy offering" for the offering at our opening worship. We are hoping to receive our offerings in shoes or boots!

Prayer Chapel – We are planning to have a Prayer Chapel available in a room near the plenary space in the Convocation Center. Thank you to Betty Royer for hosting this. You are welcome to visit this space if you wish to find a quiet environment for prayer and meditation.



The Eastern Regional Youth Events Supports the LeMoyne Community Center in Washington PA

The **LeMoyne Community Center** in Washington, PA (about 30 minutes from the CALU campus) has a very rich history dating back to the 1800s when successful carriage maker, Robert Forrest, opened his home to feed and care for the poor in the area. Upon his death, he left his property to the African American community. This Christ-like love of neighbor, love of children, and good stewardship of the little piece of creation in his care has continued throughout the property's history as this home and property was eventually transformed into a center that fed, educated, and supported the needs of this under severed community. Today the property has a community garden and playground, a head start program, a feeding program (at the center and mobile), and several programs that serve neighbors of various ages and needs.

The Penn West Conference of the United Church of Christ is so grateful for the opportunity to work with this dynamic center. The youth from this year's Eastern Regional Youth Event will be working with the Center on various mission opportunities such as working in the garden and on the grounds, preparing and serving meals, and teaching youth at the various feeding sites. Our youth will all have an opportunity to put their faith into action and participate in and witness the three great loves that are woven into the fabric of the LeMoyne Community Center—love of neighbor, love of children, and love of creation.
