Located in beautiful and historic Huntingdon, PA, the Abbey has been serving God for over 200 years. The Congregation embraces the slogan "We are Family" as part of our congregational identity.

We have an active membership of 100 with approximately 55-65 attending regularly. Worship at the Abbey is a blended service in the Reformed tradition that touches all ages. Music is a treasured part of our worship through a variety of musical talents: our choir, a hand bell choir, instrumentalists and special music like our own Abbey Trio!

We value Christian education, offering four Sunday School classes each week (Kindergarten/Early Elementary, Late Elementary, Middle/High School, and Adult). We also have summer VBS.



The Abbey Church was built in 1929 in the style of Westminster Abbey of London. Once inside, you will notice the beautiful wooden vaulted ceiling reminiscent of Noah's ark and colorful stained glass windows that depict bible stories, church history, and community history.

Our town is located 40 minutes from Altoona and State College and there are many recreational activities in the area including Raystown Lake. The town was listed as #5 on Budget Travel Magazine's list of "Coolest Small Towns in America" in 2009. In 2015, niche.com listed Huntingdon as the 3rd best town to live in the state of Pennsylvania along with a top 10 ranking in one of the safest places to reside in PA!!!!
